Volunteer at King's Church Iver

Many of the activities we organise are run by volunteers and we are aware without our volunteers we couldn't run them!

We are looking for more people to join our fantastic teams. There are so many opportunities to get involved with King's Church such as:

Hub - every Tuesday 9:30am-11:15am (Term Time only)

Hub is our parent and toddler group. We would like more help with preparing refreshments, washing up and serving teas & coffees.

Kings Place Café - every Wednesday 2pm-4pm

At Kings Place Café, over 55's are invited to join us for tea, coffee, cake, chat, a quiz and prayer. We currently need more help in the kitchen, washing up, serving teas & coffees and baking cakes!

Community Support - every other Thursday 2pm-6pm

A bi-weekly food box scheme for families and individuals who are struggling to provide for themselves. Volunteers hand out food to people collecting and get to know people in the community. We also welcome non perishable food donations.

Church Maintenance and Gardening

We want to look after our building for the fantastic activities that happen all through the week and the people who come in. If you are a keen DIY enthusiast that can help with small DIY jobs that come up from time to time in the church please let us know that you can help.

There is also a small garden area around the church building that occasionally needs a bit of TLC. Why not come and use your gardening skills with us?

SUNDAY SERVICES

We need help with our Sunday morning church services. Our teams are run through a rota, usually only requiring a once a month commitment.

Setting up/down for the service

This includes putting out/away tables and chairs, preparing the creche area, putting up notice boards and bringing the cross over from the church hall.

Technical Set up

Don't be put off by the word technical as training is given here. This role requires arriving before the service to plug everything in!

Sound & Words

Training is also given to our Sound & words team. These are vital during our service and are used mainly during our time of sung worship.

Welcome

The act of welcoming people into the Church is so important! Volunteer to say hello and put a smile on people's faces as they come into the church service.

Making and serving teas & coffees

How about serving teas and coffees before our church service starts and also at the end of the service? This is done in pairs so you are never on your own.

Sunday Service - Children's Work

After the worship songs in the village hall, the younger members of our congregation leave the adults and join one of our King's Kids groups – We are always looking for more people to nurture and grow the next generations! (Please note: you will be required to have a DBS check to work with children)

Younger Children's Leaders and Helpers (Rise)

Rise is for 3–6 year-olds, the children are taken from the village hall to our main church building, to have fun, play games, listen to stories, and sing songs together.

Older Children's Leaders and Helpers (Shine)

Shine is our 7-10's group who share a space with our youth group, Ignite, in a room at the back of Iver Village Hall. Volunteers take them to the room for crafts, games, puzzles, and conversation.

Youth Leaders and Helpers (Ignite)

Ignite is our youth group for 11–18 year-olds, sharing the room at the back of Iver Village Hall with Shine. They are treated to hot chocolate as they discuss topics, have a space to ask questions, and enjoy games.
