Introducing our new renewed, refreshed and rebuilt vision - **simply serving Jesus.**

We are a community of believers who serve Jesus in Iver and beyond, showing His love to those around us. As a church family we want to put Jesus at the centre of who we are and what we do. This means that everything we do as a church family is done **with Jesus, through Jesus, and for Jesus.**

With Jesus - In the beginning God made the world and said it was 'good' (Genesis 1) but humans managed to quickly make a mess of it (Genesis 3 onwards). Since humanity messed it up, God has been actively working at making it good again. At King's, many of us know that this has happened in us personally, but we also know that Jesus wants us to partner with Him in being part of the process of making creation good again. That involves bringing God's peace, hope and love to the people we meet and the places we go. We're not doing that on our own, we're doing it with Jesus.

Through Jesus - Christianity is the only religion where a person's God comes and lives in the person (1 John 4:15-16, Romans 8:10, 2 Corinthians 13:5, Philippians 2:13). This is described in the Bible as the Holy Spirit and it's through Him in us that we are empowered to be who we are and do what we do.

For Jesus - "We love because he first loved us." 1 John 4:19. We are people who have experienced God's love and forgiveness through the work of Jesus. We believe that the only reasonable response to that is to live our lives for Him. We love God and our neighbour, which Jesus considered the most important rule to live by. We're not doing this so people think we're great, we're doing this for Jesus.
