Actions speak louder than words...

There is an old saying that "Actions speak louder than words." In Galatians 5:22-23, we read about the fruits of the Spirit; "love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control." When the Lord blesses us with these gifts and we show them, people can be attracted to them, and opportunities to share our faith are multiplied.

The Spirit of God gave Jesus' apostles the ability to speak in many languages on that day of Pentecost written about in Acts 2, and the same Spirit enables us to speak and to act in winsome ways today. Through the power of the Spirit, God's kingdom is advancing, and he has called and equipped each of us to be his witnesses in whatever circumstances we may find ourselves.
