With and without the Holy Spirit...

In between the Resurrection and the Ascension, Jesus spent 40 days teaching the disciples - explaining how all they had seen was foretold in the Scriptures and was part of God's perfect plan. We're told the disciples were full of joy and praise - it must have been so tempting to go and tell everyone the good news of Jesus. But Jesus knew that without the empowering gift of the Holy Spirit, all their efforts would be in vain: so he told them to wait until the day of Pentecost. And so the church was born and grew powerfully. And today, it's the same lesson - without the Holy Spirit, all our efforts will be in vain too: but with Him, our witness and our church life will be supernaturally powerful.
