## Hold onto God's truths!

Recently I was visiting a friend whom I've known for many years. This friend is a child of God and is going through a really tough time at the moment. They are struggling with life and struggling with being here. Getting through each day is incredibly difficult. They are doubting their faith.

I asked them; "Do you still believe that God exists?" "Yes" they said "but I'm struggling."

On the day of Pentecost when the Holy Spirit came some of God's people didn't feel anything and so they doubted. However, Peter reminded them of who they were and he reminded them of God's promises and faithfulness. Just like Peter, we need to declare the truth. The fact is we're never alone.** God sent the Holy Spirit to live in us and with us, no matter what we're feeling, no matter what we're going through. These are facts and we need to be reminded of them.

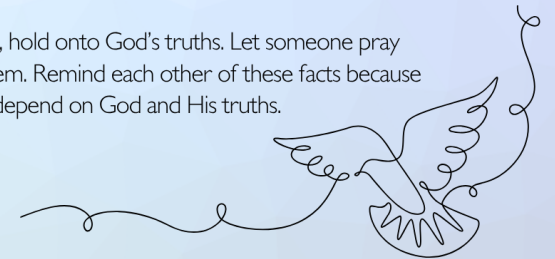
