25th January & 1st February 2026

The headlines don't get the final word — Jesus does.

On my drive to work, I tend to listen to Premier Praise. It's a great way to worship God on the way to and from work, and I really enjoy starting the day with my heart pointed in the right direction. But every morning at 8am, I switch over to BBC Radio 2 for the headlines. The other day I did just that — and it was the same familiar pattern. Five minutes of Trump this, Putin that, Prime Minister this, weather warning that. You know the drill. It's heavy. It's relentless. It feels like the world is constantly on the brink. I didn't even make it to the end of the sports section — I just switched straight back to Premier.

And the very first words I heard were: **"You've already won."**

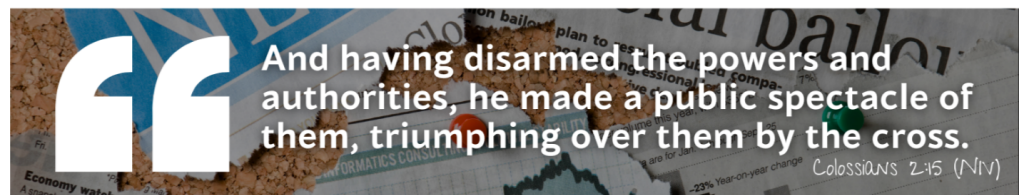
I actually stopped (not literally, I was safely driving) and thought, "Wow... that is so true." It's a song by Shane & Shane, and it reminded me of something we so easily forget when we're surrounded by bad news and uncertainty: no matter how dark things look, no matter how loud the world shouts fear at us — Jesus has already won. That's exactly what Jesus meant when he said:

"In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world."
(John 16:33)


We don't deny that life is hard. We don't pretend the news isn't real. But we listen to it through a different lens. We live from a different truth. Knowing that Jesus has already won doesn't remove our challenges, but it does change how we face them — with courage instead of panic, prayer instead of despair, and trust instead of fear. The headlines don't get the final word — Jesus does.

And that can continue to change how we journey into this year. Not with denial, not with naivety, but with deep, steady hope — because Jesus has won. So as we listen to the news this week, may we also listen more closely to His voice, anchoring our hearts in the truth that He reigns.
