# King's News.

22nd February & 1st March 2026

## Jesus doesn't just sit above the fog — He breaks through it.

Just before the weather became a little milder in mid-January, there was a cold, foggy morning. After dropping our daughter off at school, I took the back roads to work — they're lovely country roads, winding through open hills.

There's one part of the drive where you steadily climb a long incline, and there aren't many trees. As I started up the hill that morning, I was suddenly wowed by seeing the sun bursting through the fog at the top, off to my left. It was breathtaking. And in that moment, I felt God give me a picture.

It was a picture of how Jesus bursts through the fog of this world — through the noise, the lies, the distractions, the heaviness. He is greater than all of it. No darkness can overcome His light and His love.

It reminded me of how people talk about "brain fog" — that feeling of not being able to see clearly, of being weighed down or overwhelmed. And spiritually, that can happen to us too. Life piles in. The noise gets louder. The fog thickens.

But if that's you today, the invitation is simple. Get yourself into a rhythm with Jesus: **Worship. Pray. Read Scripture. Spend time in His presence.**

Because His light in your life is greater than all the noise of the world. He doesn't just sit above the fog — He breaks through it. As it says in John 1:5: **"The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it."**

That's why the song, 'Greater Than It All' by *Jake & Mates*, feels so right — because it reminds us that Jesus is greater than every fog, every fear, every voice, and every shadow we face.
