## The Mountain Manifesto

As we continued our series exploring Mountain moments in Scripture last week, Steve shared a timely message, especially given what is happening in the world right now. You can listen to this talk, and others in the series, on our website.

Two passages — Matthew 4: 1-11 (particularly verses 8-11) and Matthew 5-7 (especially Chapter 5 and the Beatitudes) — one displaying kingdoms, the other defining the Kingdom.

From one mountain, the enemy tempts Jesus: "Will you bow?"  
From another mountain, Jesus teaches the crowds: "Will you serve?"  
On the first mountain, Satan offers power without sacrifice.  
On the second, Jesus reveals transformation through surrender.

The difference is profound. One moment is testing; the other is teaching. One kingdom is marked by domination. The other is displayed through love, humility, mercy, and righteousness.

Jesus does not abolish the Law — He fulfils and deepens it, bringing it to its fullest meaning. The Kingdom He announces is not outward performance but inward transformation. Not simply rule-keeping, but heart-changing. Not "Will you bow?" — but "Will you become like Me?"

Life can feel overwhelming. We are tested every day — not just during Lent, but continually. Pressures, distractions, temptations, fears. Yet we have a Lord who loves us and blesses us so that we can bless others. As we continue this Lenten journey, re-centre your spiritual compass. Sit under the mountain words of Jesus. Allow His Spirit to shape your heart. Bless His name at all times, and He will change you.

The world sees the light of His Kingdom when disciples live differently — forgiving, serving, showing mercy, pursuing righteousness. Through the good works of Jesus' followers, the Father in Heaven is glorified. Kingdoms are defined by their values. Kingdoms are displayed by their people. May we be people who shine.
