Words I grew up hearing from an early age as a huge fan of Star Trek. As a proud Trekkie — and someone who also loves Star Wars and Doctor Who — it's probably my favourite genre on both the small and the big screen.

Joseph has an astronaut nightlight in his room that projects stars and a colourful, nebula-like pattern across the ceiling. The other evening, as I was putting him to bed, I sat on the floor and looked up at those familiar sights. But as I sat there, I found myself thinking: God made the heavens and the earth — the One who flung the stars into space.

It was a small but powerful reminder that God is so immense He could create the vastness of the cosmos, yet He longs to be in relationship with us, His creation. Let that sink in for a moment. Pretty wild, isn't it?

As I reflected on it, my mind drifted back to those famous words spoken as the USS Enterprise flies across the screen, famously voiced by William Shatner and Sir Patrick Stewart — but with a slight change: where *One* man has gone before.
