# King's News.

## “Surely I am with you always...”

A few Sundays ago, Maria helped bring our series on the mountain-top moments in Scripture to a close, finishing with the Great Commission and the ascension.

At the end of the ascension, Jesus leaves His disciples with a blessing — and they respond in a striking way: they return with great joy. It's a simple detail, but an important one. In a moment of change, uncertainty, and waiting, they walk away not in fear, but in joy. It raises a question for us: how often do we truly walk in that same joy? How often do we allow ourselves to live in the blessing that Jesus has already given us?

So often, life feels rushed. We move quickly from one thing to the next, rarely pausing long enough to reflect, to be renewed, and to refuel in the power of the Holy Spirit. Yet Jesus' promise still stands: “Surely I am with you always.” (Matthew 28:20)

His presence isn't distant or occasional — it is constant. And from that presence flows a deep, sustaining joy. Not a fleeting happiness, but something far stronger: “the joy of the Lord is your strength.” (Nehemiah 8:10) This joy isn't just for us to hold onto privately. It's something we are called to carry into our everyday lives — to share in our conversations, our actions, and the way we love those around us.

So today, take a moment. Pause. Reflect. Receive again the blessing of Jesus. And then go — not hurried or weary — but strengthened by His joy, and ready to share it with the world around you.

Lord Jesus, thank You for the blessing You give us and for the promise of Your presence with us always. Help us to slow down, to rest in You, and to be renewed by Your Spirit. Fill us with Your joy, that we may walk in it each day and share it with those around us. Amen.
